Anxiety and Depression in Children



Reduce Stress - Excessive stress and tension in your home (e.g. arguing, too many lessons/activities etc.) can have a negative effect on your child. Look at ways to reduce stress. For instance, plan some fun each day (even if it's only 5 minutes) to read a story, go for a walk, watch a movie together, do a mind-fulness activity or listen to music. Also try to deal with conflict between family members when it arises (family meetings to discuss problems). Parents also need to be careful not to express frustration or anger by arguing or rais-

ing voices around their children and being mindful that children do not need to be a part of all adult conversations.

Make a routine - Establish specific times for meals, homework, quiet time and bed time. Even 12 year olds need to be in bed by 9:00pm. Adults need time away from their children too! Establish a routine which includes showering, reading, chatting, sleep. Electronic devices should be discouraged as part of the bedtime ritual.

Work together - It is important that you and your partner work together to help your child manage their anxiety. If parents are not consistent, it can be very confusing for your child. Try to agree on ways of handling your child's anxiety (e.g. both agreeing to limit giving excessive reassurance or both following through on setting limits, such as not having the child sleep in your room) and be consistent in terms of rewards.

Mindfulness



Over the last decade, mindfulness has been slowly rising in popularity with many individuals practising it on a regular basis. Evidence based research has found that there are many benefits to mindfulness which has prompted schools across the nation to implement this practice into their daily routines.

Mindfulness can be described as attention training for your brain, enabling you to focus on something without judgement and to stimulate curiosity. Mindfulness can be practised in a number of ways and is something that can be done by everyone -

no matter what your age! It has been practised by many cultures around the world, but it is not exclusively affiliated to any particular philosophy or religion.

Mindfulness helps improve memory, engagement and performance. Its positive effect on the brain can improve immunity, mental wellbeing, learning ability, emotional health and even, time management. It is especially important in this era of information overload as our attention is constantly being pulled in many directions making us more distracted.

We have a fun and exciting program planned for the January holiday period. With Water fun days, Incursions and Excursions to the Theatre and Ninjas.

Vacation Care bookings are NOW OPEN to ALL students enrolled at Wideview Public School. This included new families to the school starting in 2019 and also all children that currently do NOT attend WOO-SCH. Places are already filling up, so if you would like to book in please ensure you don't wait too long to secure your place.

To book in for Vacation Care please complete the booking form found in the newsletter and email it to <u>wooshcholidays@gmail.com</u> once sent you will receive an email to confirm your child's days.

VACATION CARE BOOKING INFORMATION

<u>GENERAL INFORMATION</u>: Vacation Care is open to all children enrolled at Wideview Public School. Please make sure that you book in quickly so that you don't miss out.

All bookings must be made via the Vacation Care Booking Form and submitted to the vacation care email: <u>wooshcholidays@gmail.com</u>

Bookings are open from Monday 12 November until Wednesday 19 December. All bookings will be confirmed by email as soon as possible. Bookings are NOT final until confirmation has been given.

Allocation of places will be based on WOOSHC priority of access guidelines, and in order of receipt of application. Places are only available to children enrolled at Wideview Public School.

There are no cancellations, refunds, credits or transfers once your booking has been processed. All bookings are final. Cancellations will incur full fees unless another day of care in the same week can be substituted. The option of an alternate day will be subject to availability.

PG and G rated movies may be shown at the centre during the vacation care period, please see an educator if you have any concerns about this.

Every effort is made to provide the activities as advertised in this brochure, however sometimes, due to circumstances out of our control, this is not possible. If an activity is cancelled we will try to provide another activity and inform families as early as possible.

Centre and Program rules are established for the safety and well-being of all children. Consistent disregard of rules may result in exclusion from the program following consultation with educators and Parents/Guardians.

HOURS: 7:00am to 6:00pm. Children are to be signed in and out by a parent/guardian between these times. Children will only be allowed to leave the Centre accompanied by an adult nominated in your enrolment form. Notice in writing is required if the child is to be collected by anyone not nominated in your enrolment form.

<u>RATIOS</u>: In House and Incursions - One educator for every 15 children as a minimum standard. Excursions - One educator to every 8 children as a minimum standard.

<u>WHAT TO BRING TO VACATION CARE:</u> Children need to bring a hat, morning tea, lunch, snacks and a refillable drink bottle. We suggest you pack a frozen ice brick with your child's lunch to help prevent the growth of bacteria and keep it cool until lunchtime. Cooking activities may be part of the day's program but they are not meal substitutes unless stated.

Children should not bring any toys (including mobile phones and MP3 players) or expensive jewellery to Vacation Care, as they may be lost. Vacation Care will not be responsible for lost valuable items. Please also note that children will NOT be able to purchase things on Excursion so please do NOT send money for excursion days.

WHAT TO WEAR TO VACATION CARE: Please clearly label all items!

Sunhat and sunscreen – No hat means children may only be allowed to play in the shade. Children without hats may miss out on outdoor activities!

Please apply sunscreen to your child every day before dropping them to Vacation Care. Sunscreen will also be applied to all children each day in the morning and afternoon. If your child has sensitive skin please ensure that you provide your own sunscreen to be applied at these times.

Clothing should be practical and sun smart. Singlet tops are not appropriate as exposed shoulders are prone to sunburn. Children who do not bring sufficient warm clothing will be loaned a jacket for a laundering fee of \$5

ENCLOSED/COVERED shoes ONLY – thongs, slides and most sandals are NOT appropriate or safe footwear at Vacation Care. Children who do not have appropriate footwear may not be able to participate in all activities.

*******<u>EXCURSIONS</u>***- Children MUST wear the WOOSHC EXCURSION T-SHIRT on each excursion day this is a compulsory requirement to attend the excursion.

T-Shirts are available from WOOSHC and will need to be ordered upon booking for vacation care. The T-Shirts cost \$10 and this fee will be added to your booking fees for vacation care.

FOOD: Breakfast and Afternoon Tea will be offered to all children attending the service.

Please help us be allergy friendly! Many children have allergies to various foods. Nut allergies are especially common.

There are to be **No nuts or nut products (including peanut butter and hazelnut spread)** in your children's lunches and snacks.

Please provide healthy snacks, morning tea and lunch. Lollies, sugary drinks and sweets are discouraged.

Please ensure your child has plenty to eat and a drink bottle to fill with water. If your child does not have a drink bottle, they will be provided with a refillable drink bottle for a fee of \$2

FEES & PAYMENTS: Daily Fees are payable for all children booked into the service on the given day. There are no cancellations, refunds, credits or transfers once your booking has been processed.

PLEASE NOTE: WHAT'S IN THE GARDEN DAY incurs an extra fee of \$5 for the take home garden.

Children who are collected after 6.00pm will incur a Late Pick Up Fee of \$15.00 per every 15 minutes late or part there of.

A \$20.00 Digital Administration Fee will be charged to all new families (who have not attended WOOSHC before) upon booking into Vacation Care.

EXCURSION DAYS:

*** Children MUST wear the WOOSHC EXCURSION T-SHIRT on each excursion day.

T-Shirts are available from WOOSHC and **will need** to be ordered upon booking for vacation care. The T-Shirts cost is \$10 and this fee will be added to your booking fees for vacation care.

Children and staff will travel by charter bus to each excursion venue. The bus will usually leave the Vacation Care Service at approximately 9.30am and return to the centre at 4.00pm. Please ensure children are dropped off by 9.00am on excursion days. Times and destinations will be advertised on Excursion Days at the Sign In/Out area.

There will be up to 45 children on each day.

For each excursion the ratio will be one educator for every eight children, ie six educators for fourty five children as a minimum.

A risk assessment with more details about each excursion can be viewed at WOOSHC if you would like to view it prior to booking.

Information on time of departure for excursions, special requirements for the day, or late changes to the program, will be displayed at WOOSHC or are available by phoning WOOSHC during opening hours. Parents/ Guardians are responsible for ensuring they have all information required.

Children will NOT be permitted to purchase food/items on excursions, please DO NOT send money with your child to Vacation Care.
