Parking around School

We would like to remind all our parents about parking safely and legally when collecting and dropping off the children, both at the start and end of the day.

We respectfully ask our parents and other family members to be mindful of private driveways, 'keep clear' and 'no parking' road markings. It is also important that we park safely in ways that do not restrict clear views of safe places to cross the road. This morning a parent was parked across the children's crossing making it extremely dangerous to crossing users and motorists. If we expect our children to follow society expectations we as adults need to do the same. To amend a quote from Monsters Inc "Your Children are always watching you—always watching." You are their model of behaviours and expectations.

The road law concerning crossings is - you must not stop your vehicle on or within 20 metres before and 10 metres after a children's crossing or pedestrian crossing.

Staff Car Park Safety

Please be reminded that for the safety of our students, the staff car park is out of bounds for students at all times, even if supervised by parents. Please use the kiss and drop zones outside the school as required.

Social Media Accounts

At our school, we have children as young as 8 who have Instagram and other social media accounts. While this is primarily an issue for parents to deal with, the school will step in when what happens on line encroaches on our daily school life.

Instagram seems to be the main social media app used at present. This is designed for 13+ years of age.

Below are taken directly from the Terms & Conditions of Instagram.

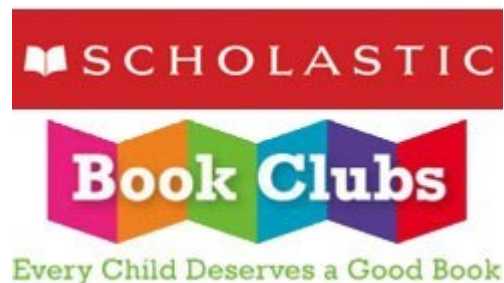
School Photos

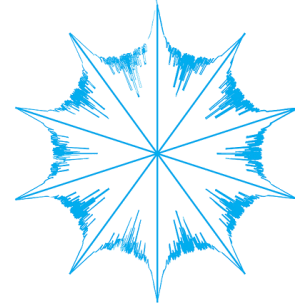

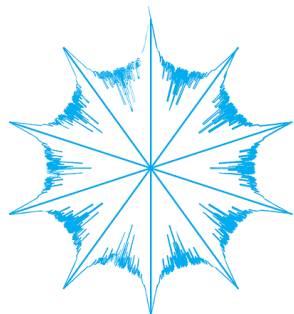
