#### **FIRES**

The past 2 weeks has deeply impacted our nation by the tragedy and devastation caused by the bush fires in rural NSW and Queensland. This hit home for our school when it was closed on Tuesday and it has brought it closer to the heart for some of our staff who have watch and act fires nearby. There has been a high level of media attention especially with the heightened vigilance on Tuesday. Many children respond to the images as well as the comments made by the media, friends and family members. Teachers are well-equipped to support students in the classroom when heightened events such as bushfires occur, even if they do not directly impact on our community. Let's all hope for lots of rain over the coming weeks and spare a thought for those out on the front line fighting the fires.

#### **Vision Valley Camp – RESCHEDULED**
