Messages from Our Principal

Reporting

At the end of each semester, all students from Kindergarten to Year 6 receive a school report. Students are given a five point scale to assess their achievement and application throughout that semester. It is very important to understand that student reports reflect how well the students have achieved what they have had the opportunity to learn.

Most of the students will receive SOUND. Receiving a 'Sound Achievement' indicates that the student has achieved expected outcomes for their stage. It shows that the student has achieved most of the skills, values and knowledge intended by the teacher when they planned the learning program for the semester. Your child is doing well.

If you have any concerns, please make an appointment with your child's teacher to discuss them.

P&C - Outstanding

Throughout this year the P&C has provided outstanding service to the school. The P&C not only coordinates fundraising events, but also provides extensive services to the school community through subcommittees and supporting/coordinating school activities. 
Successful Students

Over the past two years we have been working on building the teachers and the student's understanding of "learning intentions" (the why) and "success criteria" (the how). Our current Stage 3 students are producing excellent work samples in the area of literacy with clearly defined learning intentions and success criteria. In every Stage 3 classroom these are displayed and available for the students to reflect on the task at hand and whether or not they are achieving the success criteria. Our school data and the NAPLAN results confirms that this approach is working for students at Wideview Public School.

Kinderlinks is our Transition to School Program. Our Kindergarten 2020 children have been coming once a week for 4 weeks. Over the last 4 weeks they have participated in literacy, numeracy and PE lessons. The children visited the computer room, library, hall, office and several of the classrooms. 1. Do I need a ticket?

Yes, either a printed one or one displayed on your phone. All seats will be labelled and ushers will assist you.

2. Will the students see other classes perform?

Yes, at the Dress rehearsal on Monday 9th December. Parents cannot watch this rehearsal.

3. What does my child wear to school on Monday 9th December?

For the dress rehearsal all students are to come to school in their uniform and bring all of their costume items. Children will get changed at school ready for the rehearsal.

5. What does my child wear to school on Wednesday 11th December for the twilight and Thursday 12th for the evening concert?

Costumes and make up, if required. A quick dinner prior to the concerts will give them stamina for the night and we request that the students do not bring food/lollies. Children are to bring a water bottle.

6. How long will the concert be?

1 1/2—2 hours with no intervals. All students will be part of a finale so once they have performed their class item they need to remain with their teachers in the classroom until collected.

7. Where will the students be when they are not performing?

In their classrooms. Students need to be signed out from their classrooms by their parents following the show.

8. What costume will the students be wearing?

Your class teacher has already been in contact with you. Some classes will have limited costumes and others will require more work. If parent involvement is required, your help would be of great assistance.

9. Times to be at school?

5:00pm for the twilight performance and 6:30pm for the evening performance

10. When will the doors be open?

15 minutes prior to the show starting.


