## **Sentral Parent Portal – New App**

Sentral is a centralised system that our school staff use daily for administration and reporting. This year we are trialling access to the Parent Portal that Sentral offers, through the use of a free app.

The portal will provide parents the opportunity to:

- view and explain student absences
- receive school messages (class, grade and school specific) and;
- update and submit student and family details

We may look to access a Sentral feature regarding interviews, to allow parents to book Term 2 Parent/Teacher Interviews through the app. If this proceeds, we will notify you of the step-by-step process.

**This app will replace the current Wideview Public School app, which many of you may have been accessing until now. From 1 April 2023, the current app will cease to be active.**

Before the end of this term, you will receive an email with step-by-step instructions of how to register and set up your unique login to access the app features.

Should you experience difficulties setting up the app, please do not hesitate to contact the school office staff for assistance.

We also look forward to hearing from you about your experience with our Parent Portal. Any feedback will be gratefully received with a view to commit to long term use, and adding further functionality.

## 4AL, 4C and 4H become Sustainable Entrepreneurs

Students in Year 4 recently spent 3 lessons working in small groups to create their own sustainable products. They drew inspiration for their ingredients from the *Swish* plant in the picture book *Weslandia*, that they have been studying this term.

They applied their knowledge of the 5 Rs (Refuse, Reduce, Reuse, Repurpose and Recycle) from Geography to design the most environmentally friendly packaging they could use. One group was so successful that their ice-cream was served in a bowl made from a leaf of the plant and the spoon was from the stem – both parts were also edible, after you've taken advantage of a discounted refill of the ice-cream!

Their creative products included soup, magical face paint, cakes, jams that allow you to fly (only for those aged over 3 years for obvious safety reasons), perfume that allows you to change to any animal you wish, a delicious drink that allows you to have the characteristic of any animal you choose, and the crowd favourite of an actual money tree – provided you nurture it well in a nice hot climate. If any of the students suddenly move to Cairns, we will know why!

They used their skills of persuasion to create advertising material and presented their products to their Year 3 peers.

Well done Year 4. We definitely have some creative geniuses in the making.



## Reminder: Year 7 2024 Enrolments for High School

Thank you to the 30 families that have already submitted their expression of interest. A reminder to all other families the online system for 2024 High School enrolments is closing 31 March 2023.

To enrol your child in Year 7 for 2024, you will need to complete an Expression of Interest for Year 6 to Year 7 transition. The EOI process is now available online.

The Expression of Interest (EOI) lets you indicate which school(s) you would like your child to attend in Year 7. After you submit an EOI and it has been assessed, your child will be offered a place at a high school.

If your child will not be attending a NSW Government high school next year, please let us know by completing the Placement Not Required Online form. If you are unsure whether they will be attending a NSW Government school (you've applied for a private school, or you are moving interstate), we ask that you still complete an EOI and follow up with your school once a decision has been made.

The online process will guide you through your options and collect the information required to make the process as smooth as possible.

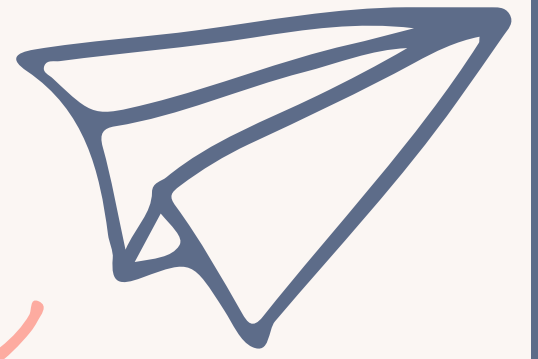
